What's God Up To? (Part 3) Ezekiel 36:22-27

Series: The Seven Questions of Spiritual Theology
Theocentric worldview – Life revolves around God. Everything
that is happening is all about God bringing ultimate glory to Himself.

Premise: He is glorifying Himself by making people -

Man's ugliness:

"Remember that you were separated from Christ – you had no hope and you were without God in the world." Ephesians 2:12 "They are darkened in their understanding, alienated from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them due to their hardness of heart." Ephesians 4:18

Question: How does God deal with man's ugliness?

God's restoration to beauty:

"I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you shall be clean from all your uncleanness, and from all your idols I will cleanse you. And I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put within you. I will remove the heart of stone...and give you a heart of flesh. I will put my Spirit within you..." Ezekiel 36:25-27; c.f. Jer. 31:31-35

"We have confidence to enter...by the blood of Jesus, by the new and living way that he opened for us through the curtain, that is, through his flesh..." Hebrews 10:19-20

"...remember that at the time you were separated from Christ...having no hope and without God in the world (ugliness)...for he himself is our peace, who has made us both one and has broken down in his flesh the dividing wall of hostility...For through him we...have access in one Spirit to the Father." Ephesians 2:12,14,18

What is God up to? He is glorifying Himself by making His children:

- Righteous because of Him Philippians 1:10,11
- Fruitful because of Him John 15:8
- Happy because of Him Isaiah 61:3

With God in the center, I can live in the deepest <u>joy</u> with God as my deepest <u>desire</u>. Therefore, I am so beautiful to God!

Opening Thoughts
