## "The Diagnostic Tools of God for My Heart" Galatians 4:8-16

Series: Justification by faith alone in Christ alone

Paul uses two diagnostic tools to help the Galatians understand the severity of the situation of falling backwards into
First Diagnostic Tool: An emphasis on <i>Form</i> rather than <i>Message vv.8-11</i>
One of the ways we know things are not right in our Christian walk is that we find ourselves back toward the way we were before Christ rescued us.
<b>Evaluation Question:</b> How do we know if we are drifting backwards?
<b>Answer:</b> There is a to an observance of forms, rather than the transforming power of the gospel. It is the content, the message and the person of Christ that matter more than the external forms.
Solution: The solution is a to God.
Second Diagnostic Tool: A Lack of Joy vv.12-16
Key verse: "What then has become of the blessing you felt?" (v.15)
Where is the that has come out of what God has done in your life through the <i>blessing</i> of your salvation/justification?
At the core of this is not feelings; the core is the that comes from God through justification by faith, which leads to joy.
<b>Paul has given us two diagnostics</b> : Falling into <i>formalism</i> rather than being enamored with the message of truth. Secondly, there is a lack of <i>joy</i> in my life.
Paul's Solution: Jesus Christ!  "Blessed are those whose lawless deeds are forgiven, and whose sins are covered; blessed is the man against whom the Lord will not count his sins."  Romans 4:7-8

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
