	David said, "I delight to do y	our will, O my God; your law is within my heart." Psalm 40:8
	When we don't know what God's Will is—then pray saying, "God, I don't know your Will, but do it whatever your Will is."

3.	Prayer is Characterized by	
	"Then I turned my face to the Lord God, seeking him by prayer and pleas for mercy with fasting and sackcloth and ashes." (v.3)
